## VADI GT

### Process Management System

Development and improvement of a digital valuation platform widely used across Latin America, allowing the management of time, impediments, communication, flexibility, personalized reporting, and a unique system for each consumer.

Responsible for the general development of the system, implementing better security, making external systems implementations (as client and service), migrating the technologies to the latest stable versions, and improving the application logs. In charge of developing new features and extending the existing ones, requiring strong knowledge of TSQL.

Team leader for a new project for the same client, in charge of analyzing and solving various points of the system related to the architecture, migrating an application with a practice like micro-frontends, with shared state management, two-way communication, security and performance, versioning of forms according to metadata and responsible for proposing a homemade implementation for i18n that the old system could use by sharing the micro-frontends dictionary.



## FOURTH PROJECT

### American Student Tuition System

Support team to synchronize student data with organizations through third parties. Enrollment Information System that manages students' data, important for the schools to do a correct process with all the relevant information such as emergency contacts, family, and medical information.

Responsible for modifying/creating basic Ruby scripts, also supporting the quality assurance of other developers' "mappings", helping other developers to find and solve issues, and explaining specific system use cases when required.



## CRUZ ROJA CR

### Benemérita Cruz Roja Costarricense

Golabs' donation consisted of the development of a new website for the Costa Rican Red Cross organization. This website was developed in CMS for specific client functions. It included coordination with a design team and implementation of client requirements.

Responsible for developing the project, finding the best implementations for the requirements, and facilitating maintenance, in some cases designing and developing specific system requirements that were not available in the CMS.



## SECOND PROJECT

### Organization Management System

SaaS application for companies that provide outsourcing services to other companies that help centralize production. Where you can manage project costs, time tracking, estimations, projects teams, business units, roles and permissions, client satisfaction levels, paid time off management, and others.

Responsible for migrating the app from Single-Tenant to Multi-Tenant, fixing the unit tests, making scripts and jobs Tenant Aware, upgrading Authentication security flow.
